



MOCAP VIRTUAL INSTRUCTION

Students and Parents/Guardian Commitments to MOCAP Virtual Instruction:

- All MOCAP enrolled students are required to take the MAP state assessment (EOC and Grade level).
- Boonville R-1 School District is not required to provide a supervised location for students taking MOCAP courses.
- Boonville R-1 School District is not required to provide access to computers, internet or other necessary technology resources to students choosing to take a MOCAP course.
- Students who enroll in MOCAP courses are expected to actively participate in those courses with the goal of completing each course. If a student does not actively participate in a course or is not successful, the district may remove the student from the MOCAP course and refuse to enroll the student in future MOCAP courses.
- Students are expected to complete all course requirements by the end of the semester as stated upon enrollment.

How do I sign my student up for a MOCAP program?

Step #3: A district committee will examine the MOCAP request to make a determination as to if the MOCAP placement is in the best educational interest. Factors for this determination could include but are not limited to:

1. The student's success or lack of success in any previous virtual courses and/or program.
2. The attendance record
3. The student's previously observed time-management skills and ability to be successful in a learning environment that requires persistence and personal accountability.

Parent/Guardians will be notified of the best educational interest determination within 10 business days of receiving the application.
